The Council on Aging offers services to check on seniors during emergency situations. It also offers shelf-stable meals for use in adverse weather.

2. Alert Chatham is a program provided by Chatham County Emergency Management that allows you to receive notifications via phone calls, text messaging, e-mail and other ways you select. This system will be used to notify you about imminent threats to health and safety as well as other notifications that may affect your home or workplace.

The CodeRED® platform is used for alerting the public directly via telephone, e-mail, SMS text, TDD, and through the CodeRED® app on their mobile devices. YOU MUST REGISTER TO RECEIVE NOTIFICATIONS. There are three ways to register:

3. S.A.F.E. Chatham is an access and functional needs registry (formerly called special needs) maintained by Chatham County for residents to indicate to emergency officials that they may need special assistance during disasters. You can register with S.A.F.E. online or over the telephone:
