



TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS IN CHATHAM COUNTY



Chatham County offers a wide variety of transportation options to suit your budget and travel needs. Below are transportation options ranging from rideshares to public transit.

Travel Options

1. Chatham Transit Networks, (919) 542-5136

Fixed Route Service: CT Express, a route that travels between Siler City, Pittsboro, and Chapel Hill.

In-County Service: You can reserve a ride two days in advance to anywhere in Chatham. Call Chatham Transit to schedule and determine fees. Visit www.chathamtransit.org for more information.

5. Lyft, Uber, and [GoGo Grandparent](#) rideshare services

Services: Both **Lyft** and **Uber** are cell phone applications (apps) that allow individuals to order a one-way “taxi” (also called ‘rideshare’) that is provided by the driver’s personal car. All drivers have received a background check and are certified. You can pay in cash, or with credit card in the app. Cost varies based on distance and you must order a ride from your current location to the location you are going prior to receiving the ride. Available rides are limited to when drivers make themselves available and may be limited (or costly) in rural parts of the county. For more information, follow this link:
